## **Parade Rules**

- 1. Registering will begin at 10:00 a.m. and will end at 12:00 p.m. on Sunday May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Registration will be held at the Newburg VRSFD.
- 2. All apparatus must be present for the participating department to register/sign in for the parade.
- 3. The parade will begin promptly at 1:00 p.m. rain or shine.
- 4. Department staff will be located at both of the schools and Elk's Lodge to assist with lining up of the units and control of pace for the units entering the parade line. CCSO will be on hand at both Rt. 257/Mt. Victoria Road and Rt. 257/Shiloh Church Rd. to assist with local traffic.
- 5. There will be department staff located before the judge's stand to assist with the pace of units as they pass in front of the stand.
- 6. You may be instructed to momentarily pause just past the judge's stand at Rt. 257/Mt. Victoria Road to allow for traffic to turn onto Mt. Victoria Road. Police will monitor traffic and stop units accordingly. Be prepared to stop ONLY if instructed to do so! Otherwise, there will be no stopping in front of the judges stand.
- 7. If you ARE NOT staying for the firemen/EMS games proceed directly to 301.
- 8. If you ARE staying for the firemen/EMS games take a right turn onto Mt Victoria, then another right on Shiloh Church Rd. on around to 257 back to the schools to park. A shuttle bus will pick you up and bring you to Newburg VRSFD where the games will be held.
- 9. Sounding of Sirens and/or air horns will result in automatic disqualification.
- 10. At the discretion of the judges, there may be compartment spot checks at any time to check how organized the vehicle is.
- 11. Judges decisions are final.
